



RUN2CURE LOCAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

By registering to take part in Run2Cure Local, I agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Registration:

I understand that it is free to participate in Run2Cure Local but am required to complete the personal fundraising page. I declare that all information provided on the page is true and correct.

2. Safety and Wellbeing:

I declare that I am 18 years or older on event day or that if I am the parent/legal guardian of a participant who is under the age of 18 years, I will be responsible for their safety and well-being.

1. I understand I am responsible for organising my own walk or run and if I am organising a team, I will advise them of any risks. I am also responsible for organising insurance if required.
2. I will adhere to all current guidelines provided by my relevant state regarding COVID-19 safety. If I am a team leader or registering multiple people, I certify that I have made all persons in my team aware of these terms and conditions, and that agreeing with them themselves, they have authorised me to register on their behalf.
3. I understand the event organisers reserve the right to delay, postpone or cancel the event for reasons outside of the event organisers control.
4. I accept that Neuroblastoma Australia will not accept any loss or damage of personal items or data or be held accountable for any injury.
5. I agree to conduct myself in a professional and courteous manner during participation in the event.

3. Risk

1. Entrants participate in the Event entirely at his or her own risk.
2. Entrants will take all reasonable measures to protect him or herself from the risks of participation.
3. Entrants accept all responsibility for travel and medical insurance and for payment and/or reimbursement of medical/surgical expenses incurred on his or her behalf.
4. Entrants acknowledge that the Event involves the real risk of serious injury or risk of death, from various causes including over-exertion, dehydration, accidents with other competitors, spectators and road users and weather conditions, just to name a few. Each Entrant (or his or her parent or legal guardian) has voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept the inherent risks of the Event.
5. To the best of each Entrant's knowledge, he or she is not suffering from a condition, which would prevent and/or render them unfit to participate in the Event. Each Entrant recognises the difficulties of participating in the Event and attests that he or she is physically fit to compete safely, have trained sufficiently and have not been advised by a qualified medical practitioner not to compete in the Event.

4. Fundraising

1. I understand fundraising for Neuroblastoma Australia is optional but an objective of the Event. Donations can be made online via the Run2Cure website and will be processed through the charity's Stripe or Paypal account.
2. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible and a receipt will be provided. I acknowledge these donations are non-refundable.
3. I understand there are fundraising incentives which may be awarded to individuals for their fundraising. The incentive prizes do not have to be accepted and can be donated back to Neuroblastoma Australia.
4. I understand if I want to hold a fundraising event to help generate more fundraising for Neuroblastoma, I need to contact Neuroblastoma Australia to be granted Authority to Fundraise and I would need to organise my own insurance and comply with the fundraising regulations in my State of Territory of Australia.

5. Fundraising Prizes

1. To be eligible to receive the (1) Run2Cure event medal after fundraising \$30 or more; (2) Run2Cure branded Steigen socks valued at \$22 after fundraising \$60 or more; (3) \$40 voucher for use in the Run2Cure online after fundraising \$150 or more; (4) Run2Cure cap valued at \$25 after fundraising \$150 or more; Run2Cure Stoj cap valued at \$25 and (5) Run2Cure Goodr sunglasses valued at \$50 after fundraising \$1000 or more; individuals must have: registered to participate in the Neuroblastoma Australia Run2Cure Local 2023, activated their fundraising page and raised the required fundraising amount for each prize level.
2. Fundraising totals will be taken from individual fundraising pages on fundraising.
